Project title: Formation and Use of Past Tenses

You set yourselves the goal to study the various past tenses in English (past simple, continuous, perfect, perfect continuous). You first wrote a text in past tense before studying the theory again, then described the formation and use of these tenses, and finally wrote a second text that should be improved by at least 25% compared to the first one, in terms of use of past tenses.

Achievements:

You described the formation and use of the tenses correctly, nicely color-coding endings and question or negative elements in the form, and adding some examples. While your first text produces forms that do not exist (“have had chosen”), mainly to do with the formation of either present perfect or past perfect forms, your second text does not produce wrong forms as such, in some instances another tense form is called for, though.

Even though the fairy tale story (text 2) is given and can easily be copied, you did write your own version of it.

Points of criticism:

- The errors occur where past perfect is needed.
- In general, very FEW past tense forms other than the past simple are used (only four: highlighted in text, no past perfect continuous).
- Thus, it is rather difficult for me to evaluate if you have actually reached your goals.

Final evaluation: 4.5 (honouring the nicely color-coded theory sheet and the few instances of use of past tense forms other than past simple)
